- Meeting started with Steve Schein Thanking everyone for coming out and acknowledged it was nice to see new faces in the audience.
- requesting the attendees to review the previous meetings minutes:
 - May Meeting minutes were reviewed.
 - Wendy Kasky executed a motion to approve
 - Doug Mason seconded that motion.
- Treasures Report:
 - Time was allotted for attendees to review the Treasures Report. Accounting changes pertained to registration payments, refunds, Registration site fees and a couple Miscellaneous expenses.
 - Jim Begg executed a motion to approve
 - Wendy Kasky seconded that motion
- President Opening Remarks: Steve Schein
 - Steve Opened with current registration values
 - § Flag (5 & 6) – 45 Owen J and Upper Perk may join our flag program helping us have more teams. Will still be non travel all games here.

 - § Cheerleading 93
 - Steve commented we needed equal number of teams for a balanced schedule
 - Steve discussed additional registration efforts suggesting seeing if the 7th grade coach had a meeting yet and to see if he can help by possibly directing those with little experience to our league
 - § Wendy Kasky commented that the 7th grade coach was not planning on having a meeting
 - § Wendy also commented how could he direct players to our league when the school is free and we have a cost
 - § Wendy suggested considering lowering registration fee for 7th graders
 - § Steve commented we need to find ways to get the word out that we have openings at all levels, but really need to push the Midget level
 - Service Project Coordinator
 - § We still need to locate a volunteer or 2 to be coordinator for this community effort

- § We will be giving more back to the community this year through various service projects. We are looking for a person to head up this program.
 - § A request for help will be sent to all registered parents.
 - Partnership with school district to improve fields behind the 7th grade building.
 - § We will need to have a volunteer fundraiser to raise necessary funds
 - § We will need to determine volunteer with specific trades to help with our improvements to fields and so forth.
 - § The hope is by 2011 we are playing on our new fields.
 - July meeting will be from 7:00 – 7:30 with coaches meeting following.
 - Scheduling for pep rally needs approval from the school district
 - Usafootball.com has a lot of useful information that would help coaches prepare practice plans and drills
 - For the upcoming season – coaches will be required to wear id badges. Those cleared to coach will be issued a badge. Only ones on the fields with players are certified coaches.
- Vice Presidents Report : Mike Engro –
 - Mentioned that we voted not to participate in out of league play for the 2010 season
 - New rules for 2010 – (mentioned in previous meetings)

- Football Director Report : Tom Dibello
 - coaches meetings one 6/6/2010
 - § 30 coaches attended
 - § Mentioned NCSI background check required for all – if you need to perform background check email tom and he will send information – Tom said he will send info to Beth so she can send to cheer coaches.
 - § Discussed
 - League goals
 - Some basic First Aid specifically dehydration & concussions
 - Equipment Fitting & pickup will be same days since we now have all the equipment
 - § 7/17/2010 (in AM) & 7/18/2010 (in PM) – dates and times will be posted on web
 - § We will load the truck and take to Limerick. Players will be fitted and they will take equipment.
 - § Registration, \$100 equipment deposit & 2 copies of Birth certificate will be required for a player to leave with their equipment
 - Extra Equipment – instead of order forms. This year we will buying bulk orders and sizes and sell. Numbers will be based on previous years. Order has been placed.
 - Tom has commissioners at all levels for the 2010 season
 - Sent in information to close out our \$10,000 grant that we received.
- Cheer Director Report : Beth Fullerton
 - 93 for cheer so far – good start
 - Cheer camp is going to happen 8/11 & 8/12.
 - Information about camp has been sent out and is available on our web site
 - June 24th Cheer will have a coaching clinic
 - Uniform distributions will be on the same dates and times as the tackle football equipment handouts.

- Steve commented that the cheer leading coaches would ALSO require background checks.
- Marketing Director Report : Jen Welsh –
 - Call for volunteer to help with snack stand. Everything runs smooth when there is help from many and not relying on one or 2.
 - Jen commented on plans to have fundraiser events – that will be voluntary.
 - § These events will target funds for the new field
 - We will be looking to fund a snack trailer as our snackstand for this year.
 - § Steve commented School District gave approval for a snack trailer for practice and can be driven over for games.
 - Bishop will do pictures again
 - § Date will be 9/18/2010
 - Blue and Gold game – possible sponsors
 - League social will be the same night as blue and gold game.
- Facilities Director report: Vince Frigo
 - Presented to School district board to have exclusive rights to the fields
 - Currently scheduling the practice field duties
 - § Clean Field
 - § Clean Shed
 - § Trash, Fuel for lights, lining fields are all tasks that need to be scheduled.
 - § Steve commented that teams will be required once again for field set up..
